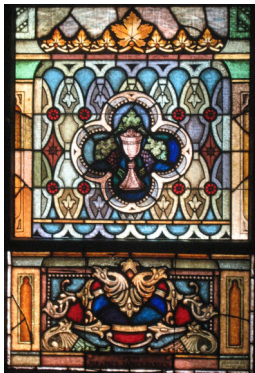

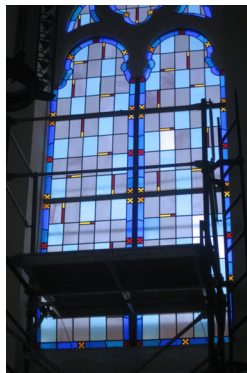


St. Edmysius, Long Beach, CA, Stained Glass Restoration

LITTLE SISTERS OF THE POOR CHAPEL WINDOWS



Stained Glass Windows in Little Sisters Chapel
15 Feet Wide and 4 Feet High

The Sisters operate a large facility for the care of the elderly in San Pedro, California and in other locations in the United States and other countries. They are widely regarded with respect and affection for their life of devoted service and the excellent care that the residents receive. In October of 2009, their founder Jeanne Jugan, was canonized by the Roman Catholic Church.

In October, 2007 the Sisters began making plans to create a private chapel in their residence and incorporating stained glass. The final design of interlocking circles was approved by the national and international hierarchy of the Little Sisters of the Poor. The panels were installed in February of 2010 to the great satisfaction and joy of the Sisters.

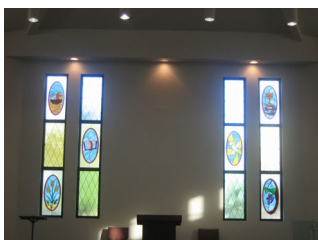

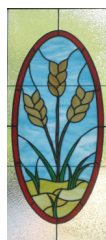
