
I have been a priest in the diocese of San Bernardino since 1978, when it was founded, having served in Lake Elsinore, until September 1, 1980 when the task of founding St. Elizabeth Ann Seton's parish, in Ontario, was entrusted to me.

We built a new church in 1990. Mark Schoem made all the arrangements and built 17 stained glass windows for our new church, starting in 1990 and continuing during four years, as we gathered the necessary funds.

At the request of Mr. Mark Schoem, this letter is being written on his behalf as he pursues future work in his field.

Mary Star of the Sea Parish employed the talented services of Mr. Schoem on four separate occasions in the restoration of the stained glass windows in our church. The church was erected in 1956 and the windows were fabricated by Harry Clarks of Dublin, Ireland. The studio in Dublin is renowned for the intricacy of design and the original colors used in each stained glass window. This created quite a challenge for Mr. Schoem when we asked him to replace broken or missing parts of our many windows.


On three different occasions, one of our largest windows (at street level) was vandalized in a very destructive manner. Mr. Schoem solved the problem of future damage by installing a protective glazing on the outside of the window, enclosing it in an aluminum frame matching the frame holding the stained glass. The completed work gave a very aesthetic appearance from the outside.

Mr. Schoem worked on our windows between the years of 1991 and 1994. In 1995, we commissioned Ancient Arts to design and fabricate etched glass panels for doors leading from the vestibule of the church into a small chapel.

We have always been extremely pleased with Mark Schoem's creations and talents. It is with the utmost confidence that we are able to recommend his gifted abilities for any project which may be offered to him.



Now that phase I, of our stained glass project has been completed, I wish to express my sincere satisfaction and appreciation for your work. It reflects true originality.


